

Articles for publication in Aquaculture Europe

– the members' magazine of the European Aquaculture Society



Aquaculture Europe is the quarterly publication of the European Aquaculture Society (EAS), specifically designed to update members on relevant developments in sustainable aquaculture in Europe. The emphasis of this quarterly publication is not “breaking news”, but more “developments and trends”.

Aquaculture Europe presents a feature article and 3-4 general articles. These will cover the important area of “grey literature” and will not be written in classical scientific paper format. These articles may also include news from commercial companies on new technologies, innovation, and other developments, but these must be positioned (and only accepted) if they put their news in the context of the current situation and compare the general benefits of new technologies, rather than providing “press release” material or similar commercial promotion. EAS will not publish or endorse commercial promotion, except through the paid advertising that it offers.

Feature Articles

An in-depth article on one or issues relating to sustainable aquaculture development in Europe.

The Feature Article is usually 6-8 pages of Times Roman 10 (single line spacing) made in MS Word with no embedded objects. All graphic content - tables, graphics and especially photos should be sent as separate files. Photos should be sent as high quality image files (TIFF) with minimum resolution 300 dpi and with suitable captions (including photo origin, e.g. photo courtesy of...). One photo that exemplifies the content of the article should be defined as the ‘cover photo’, and should be of sufficient size and quality (as well as being aesthetically pleasing). It will form the cover of that issue of the magazine.

Other articles

General articles on countries, technology, research, industry developments...

These articles are generally shorter and may be anonymous. They would usually be of 2-3 pages of Times Roman 10 (single line spacing) made in MS Word with no embedded objects. All graphic content should be sent as separate files, as above.

News updates/requests

Short updates and/or information on all European aquaculture-related issues.

A maximum of one page of text, with (possibly) a link to more information, where relevant. Not usually accompanied by graphic content, but may be accompanied by one photo.

Scientific papers
